

Listed below for consideration are the funding recommendations for these organizations in FY 2005/06. All of these organizations were funded by EDA last fiscal year. EDA requests authority to negotiate the non-monetary conditions of County participation, which may include membership benefits, marketing activities input, and County sponsorship recognition. Funding will be provided through a variety of EDA resources including CDBG, RDA, WIA, Aviation, and EDA Administration.
