SUBJECT: SB 621 Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund Grant Award

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors accept the recommendation of the Riverside County Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee (CBC) to award grant funds to the Registrar of Voters and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the Memorandum of Understanding.

BACKGROUND: In January 2005, the Registrar of Voters applied for grant funds from the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund. Funds in the amount of \$173,000 were requested to purchase a motorhome-type vehicle that would be designed and outfitted for use primarily as a roving early voting site. Other proposed uses include an outreach classroom, mobile "branch office," and emergency voting venue. The vehicle would also be suitable for use as a replacement polling place if a designated site is unable to operate on Election Day.

On June 27, 2005, the Riverside County Indian Gaming Local CBC awarded the Registrar of Voters the full amount of the grant request. The Registrar's Office is embarking on an ambitious schedule to have the vehicle ready to deploy for use in the November 8, 2005 Consolidated Special Statewide Election.
