SUBJECT: Railroad License Agreement between the County of Riverside and the Riverside County Transportation Commission for the installation of new Traffic Signal, Lighting and Roadway Improvements Project at State Highway 74 (SH-74) and Sherman Road.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the attached Railroad License Agreement between the County of Riverside and the Riverside County Transportation Commission and authorize the Chairman of The Board to execute the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside Transportation Department plans to install new traffic signal, lighting, and roadway improvements at the intersection of SH-74 and Sherman Road to improve intersection operations and safety.

The proposed roadway improvements include construction of a raised median on SH-74, and the widening of the south leg of Sherman Road to provide a raised median for the installation of railroad crossing warning lights and gates.

BACKGROUND: (continued)

To construct the proposed improvements, it is necessary to enter into and to place signal equipment on Riverside County Transportation Commission railroad right-of-way.

This Agreement is necessary to provide the County right-of-entry into and placement of signal equipment in the Riverside County Transportation Commission railroad right-of-way for the construction of the proposed improvements.

The cost for preparation and processing the Railroad License Agreement is estimated at \$2,000. We recommend approval of the Railroad License Agreement.
