- 2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign subsequent grant award amendments pertaining to Agreement #05-45159 limited to the shifting of funds between budgetary line items as needed to facilitate the delivery of program services. Any amendments which alter the original approved total grant award or change any given fiscal year's revenues or modify the lifetime of the grant will be brought to the Board of Supervisors for approval; and

- 3) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign nine (9) originals of the contract.

**Background:** The Riverside County Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program (CLPPP) provides direct case management for children. Additionally, CLPPP educates the communities, families, and health care providers within its jurisdiction. CLPPP also coordinates with a range of local agencies and organizations on lead-related activities, alerts the State to new sources of lead exposure and barriers in the continuum of care and prevention, and helps develop creative new strategies towards realizing a mutual vision of a healthy, lead-safe environment in which all children can achieve their full potential.

On April 25, 2005, this Agreement was received from the State of California Department of Health Services and preparation of this Form 11 began.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

**Financial Impact:** No County General Funds will be required.

**Financial Information:** The CLPPP receives 100% of its funding from the State. The Agreement #04-45159 covers three fiscal years; the funding amounts by Federal Fiscal Year(s) and the corresponding County Fiscal Year(s) are reflected in the following table:
