**SUBJECT:** Service Agreements with Clinicas de Salud del Pueblo, Inc., and Neighborhood Healthcare

**BACKGROUND:**

The services on these Agreements outline the specific public health and primary care services that are required of each of these organizations. The agreements establish minimum hours of operation, and assure that all required services are being provided at each of these locations

Neighborhood Healthcare is willing to provide clinic health services to the community for and in consideration of operational space provided by the County of Riverside. Neighborhood Healthcare will reimburse the County the amount of \$3,112.00 per month for the maintenance, operation and use of the premises. The lease and license, for Neighborhood Healthcare, to occupy the Temecula Family Care Center was approved by the Director of Facilities Management on April 15, 2005. The Director of Facilities Management has the authority to execute such documents per County Board approved Policy B-18.

Arrangement is being processed separately, from the service agreement, for Clinicas de Salud del Pueblo, to occupy the new County of Riverside owned Clinic building in Mecca. The lease agreement will be submitted for Board of Supervisors approval on the same agenda as this item. Clinicas de Salud del Pueblo will pay Riverside County for the lease of the Clinic building in Mecca the amount of \$7,382.25 per month. Clinicas de Salud del Pueblo will provide public services to residents from surrounding communities, farm and migrant workers; and will be compensated through the patients being served.

These agreements have been approved as to form by County Counsel and Risk Management.
