RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to approve and execute the attached Agreement between Riverside County Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) and Alternatives to Domestic Violence, to provide Domestic Abuse Advocacy Intervention Services. The total amount of the Agreement is not to exceed \$243,226 for the period of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006.
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to approve and execute any future amendments to this Agreement and exercise renewal options for an amount not to exceed the maximum agreement amount.
3. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the terms of this Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

On April 28, 2005, Riverside County Purchasing and Fleet Services released on its website, Request for Proposal (RFP) #PUARC632 seeking competitive proposals from qualified vendors to provide Domestic Abuse Intervention Advocacy Services for CalWORKs applicants and recipients. Two (2) proposals were received (Alternatives to Domestic Violence & Shelter from the Storm) in response to the RFP and both were deemed responsive and responsible. After careful review and evaluation Alternatives to Domestic Violence (ADV) was recommended for award of Contract in Western Riverside, and Shelter From the Storm (SFTS) was recommended for award of Contract in Eastern Riverside. SFTS Contract will be presented to the Board under a separate Form 11.

ADV provides domestic abuse advocacy services to the recipients of the Central and Western portions of Riverside County. ADV services include case management, individual counseling, referrals to medical and social services, relocation assistance and emergency shelter, parenting programs, temporary restraining order assistance, court accompaniment and life skills training which include financial planning, anger management, and coping with stress.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Contract will be funded with Federal funds. No County funds are required. Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the FY 05/06 County budget.
