SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENTS

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approves and:

1. Authorizes the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Supportive Housing Program (SHP) one-year renewal Grant Agreements between the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) not to exceed the aggregate amount of \$1,065,552 for:
 - a. Operation SafeHouse for \$135,756 for the period of March 1, 2005 through February 28, 2006;
 - b. Desert Aids Project for \$124,990 for the period of May 1, 2005 through April 30, 2006;
 - c. Saint Vincent De Paul for \$525,000 for the period of December 1, 2005 through November 30, 2006; and
 - d. Lutheran Social Services for \$279,806 for the period of November 1, 2005 through October 31, 2006.
2. Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to sign the Contracts between DPSS and the above project sponsors;
3. Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to sign any ministerial amendments with these project sponsors, not to exceed the maximum amount of each Grant Agreement; and
4. Authorizes the Director of DPSS to administer the agreements with the project sponsors.

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BACKGROUND:

On July 13, 2004, (Agenda Item 3.37), your Honorable Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included renewal funding for supportive housing programs operated by the following Project Sponsors:

Operation SafeHouse—Main Street Transitional Living Project provides transitional housing for homeless youth in District 1;

Desert Aids Project—Casas San Miguel Project provides supportive services for individuals living with HIV/AIDS in District 4;

Saint Vincent De Paul Management—Martha's Village Project provides transitional housing for singles and families in District 4; and

Lutheran Social Services—MARB Amelia's Light Project provides transitional housing and intensive supportive services to families in transition in District 5.

HUD executed the attached Grant Agreements and provided them to DPSS, which we are submitting to your Board for approval.
