SUBJECT: Federal Equitable Sharing (Asset Forfeiture) Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors approve the attached Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement and the Federal Annual Certification Report for submission to the U.S. Department of Justice, the Department of the Treasury and this District's U.S. Attorney and authorize the Chairman and the Sheriff to be cosignatories on both documents.

BACKGROUND: The Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice continues the County's participation in the Federal asset forfeiture program through September 30, 2008. Asset forfeiture funds will continue to be used for law enforcement services provided through the Sheriff's Special Investigations Bureau. The Federal Annual Certification Report provides an analysis of asset forfeiture funds received during the preceding fiscal year.

The U.S. Department of Justice and the Department of the Treasury require the submission of these documents to maintain qualification to receive forfeiture funds or property. These agencies require Board review and approval of the Agreement and Report and authorization of their submittal. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.
