## Report to Board of Supervisors for year 2004

June 27, 2005

### MEETINGS:

The Riverside County Historical Commission cancelled one meeting, held one special meeting and held five regular meetings for year 2004.

### ACTIONS TAKEN:

1. 2/19/04: Historical Commission Trust Fund monies were approved to reprint 500 copies of "The Bradshaw Trail" book and to fund the next History Workshop.
2. 3/18/04: The "Education Subcommittee" was tabled to an indefinite future time that a need arises.
3. 3/18/04: The Commission approved the use of the old bricks by the Gilman Ranch Hands to be used as a fund raiser for the Gilman Ranch facility.
4. 7/22/04: The Historic Preservation Officer resigned 7/10/04. (Position remained vacant until 3/31/05.)
5. 7/22/04: John Worden was elected Chair for 2004-2005.
6. 7/22/04: A resolution from the Board of Supervisors was requested in support of the California Preservation Foundation's annual meeting and conference for May, 2005.
7. 7/22/04: A book sale policy was approved; and amended 9/16/04.
8. 9/6/04: Charlene Cleary was elected Vice-Chair for 2004-2005.
9. 9/16/04: A subcommittee was formed to write an award program to honor individuals and societies involved in historic projects.
10. 9/16/04: A subcommittee was formed to discuss the ending of the Cultural Heritage Tourism Committee, to see what projects can be done by the Historical Commission. It was decided to produce a map listing all of the Riverside County historic sites. Each group listed would have access to the maps. The project will be assigned to the new HPO, who was just recently hired.
11. 11/3/04: The Commission prepared a letter to get further information in support of the preservation of the De Anza Trail, Bautista Canyon Road.

COMMISSIONER COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT:

Commission members are active in the preservation community, serving as liaisons for historical information. Commission members tour historic sites on a regular basis to enhance the awareness of Riverside County's cultural resources.

HISTORY WORKSHOP:

This 2004 History Workshop was held at the historic Benedict Castle on Chicago Avenue in Riverside on April 16, 2004. The theme was "Castles to Bungalows, Historic Architecture of Riverside County". The focus of the conference was on the historic architecture in Riverside County and how to conduct research on an historic property.

GILMAN RANCH GROUND BREAKING:

The Commissioners attended the groundbreaking for the reconstruction of the Gilman Ranch House on October 4, 2004. Chairman John Worden helped break ground for the reconstruction of the Nationally Registered site.


