SUBJECT: Ratify the Sixth Amendment to the Agreement with D & D Disposal, Inc.

BACKGROUND continued:

This is an ongoing Agreement with D & D Disposal for the provision of small and large animal removal, disposal and freezer containment services for the County of Riverside, Department of Animal Services. D & D Disposal, Inc. is reimbursed on a per-animal fee basis for large dead animal services and on a weekly pick-up basis for small dead animal services.

To comply with County of Riverside policy, the Department of Animal Services issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) on April 18, 2005 for large and small animal pick up and disposal. D & D Disposal, Inc. was the sole responder. They continue to be the only vendor in Central and Southern California who provide these services.

The RFP is currently in review and we anticipate completion by October, 2005. However, in order to prevent a lapse in service, we are requesting a six (6) month contract extension through December, 2005, to allow for the completion of the RFP process and a decision for service to be made. The cost for these six (6) months is exactly half of that charged during FY04/05.
