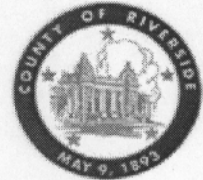

SUBJECT: Consolidation of Special Elections

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve consolidation of special municipal, school district and special district elections with the November 8, 2005 Consolidated Special Statewide Election and authorize the Registrar of Voters to conduct subject elections for the City of Indian Wells, the Jurupa Unified School District and the Palo Verde Health Care District pursuant to their respective resolutions.

BACKGROUND: California Elections Code §10403 allows jurisdictions to request consolidation of special elections by submitting a resolution to the Board of Supervisors not later than the 88th day before the November 8, 2005 Consolidated Special Statewide Election. The City of Indian Wells, the Jurupa Unified School District and the Palo Verde Health Care District have complied with this requirement and request consolidation of their special elections. These jurisdictions normally hold elections in the even-numbered years. The contests and measures to be placed on the ballot are attached as Exhibit A.

The department has the resources to consolidate these elections concurrently with this year's Consolidated Special Statewide Election. The city, school and special districts will reimburse the department based on associated direct costs for each jurisdiction.
