BACKGROUND: (Continued).

Since 2000, the California Department of Health Services has awarded local health departments local assistance funds for regional immunization registries. Riverside County joined with the existing San Bernardino Department of Public Health immunization registry in July 2000 to form the VaxTrack Immunization Registry (formerly known as the Inland Empire Immunization Tracking System). VaxTrack is an interagency project with the goal of improving the health of the community by assuring that all children receive appropriate preventive services, particularly immunizations. The goal of VaxTrack is to link all providers including public and private providers, managed care, hospital-based health delivery systems and other agencies, such as schools, foster care, and WIC, within each of the participating counties to a central database for the coordinated registry of immunization information on children. To date, VaxTrack has achieved 100% public provider participation and more than 60% private provider participation. There are also more than 130 eligible schools and day care providers currently participating in VaxTrack as well.

Riverside County Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health has been awarded funding in the amount of \$228,749 to continue with the expansion and maintenance of the immunization registry within Riverside County. This is an on-going regional grant from the Statewide Immunization Information System Program of the State Department of Health Services Immunization Branch.
