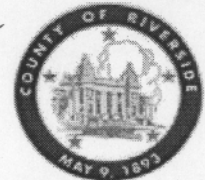

BACKGROUND: On June 28, 2005, Item 3.30 the Board approved Managed Care contracts with various managed care providers. The Agreements were developed based on projected utilization and rates for managed care services. Dogon subsequently requested an increase in reimbursement rates based on their increased costs of doing business as justified by recent cost

BACKGROUND: Continued

Dogon has participated in the Riverside County Mental Health Plan as an organizational provider of outpatient mental health services, which include, medication services, group therapy, psychological testing and crisis intervention since the Plan's inception in 1997. During this time period, the reimbursement rate for services provided by Dogon has not increased.

Dogon anticipates continuing to work with the Riverside County Department of Mental Health to meet the need for the provision of specialty mental health medication services within the area they serve. This amendment reflects an increase to the rates for services and a decrease of units of services in order keep the contract maximum the same. There is no financial impact.
