SUBJECT: 2005 DAVID GOLDWARE FRIENDS OF THE VETERAN PROCLAMATIONS AND RECOGNITION

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board of Supervisors accept the recommendations of the Veterans' Advisory Committee and issue the attached proclamations naming Donald K. Galbraith and Martin Luther King High School as the recipients of the 2005 David Goldware Friends of the Veteran Awards and recognize other competition finalists.

BACKGROUND:

In 1999 the Riverside County Veterans' Advisory Committee (VAC) created the annual David Goldware Friend of the Veteran Awards to recognize community volunteers who distinguish themselves through service to veterans. The award is named after local philanthropist and activist, David Goldware, a proud Navy veteran whose many years of community service included countless projects benefiting veterans. In 2004 the VAC added a second category to recognize businesses and groups who go above and beyond their normal mission to serve veterans.

At the October 18 presentation the Board will be joined by VAC Chairman Daryl James, the County Veterans' Services Officer, and Michael Goldware to help coordinate the presentations.
