**SUBJECT:** Approve the Agreement with Los Angeles Biomedical Research Institute at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center for Statewide Evaluation of Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMS-C).

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the Agreement with Los Angeles Biomedical Research Institute at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center (LA BioMed) formerly known as Research and Education Institute (REI) at Harbor UCLA from the date of execution through December 31, 2005 in the amount of \$27,422; and
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson of the Board to sign four (4) originals of the Agreement on behalf of the County.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved funding from the State of California Emergency Medical Services Authority on December 23, 2002, Item 3.11 to evaluate the utilization of emergency medical services for children (EMS-C) to better serve this population. The Community Health Agency

**SUBJECT:** Approve the Agreement with Los Angeles Biomedical Research Institute at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center for Statewide Evaluation of Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMS-C).

**BACKGROUND** (continued):

sub-contracted with REI at Harbor UCLA to complete the majority of project activities which have included addressing the need for more information on the development, implementation and sustainability of EMS-C components within the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agencies in the State of California. The Agreement with REI expired in December 31, 2003.

On January 25, 2005, Item 3.4, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors (BOS) approved new funding from the California Emergency Medical Services Authority to continue the EMS-C. With the funding allocation of \$27,422, LA BioMed, formally known as REI at Harbor-UCLA, will conduct site visit evaluations to the eight (8) remaining EMS agencies, compile all data and provide a summary report to the State that includes the entire EMS-C Statewide evaluation results.

**JUSTIFICATION FOR DELAY:** Contract negotiations with LABioMed were not finalized until July 19, 2005. This Form 11 and attachments were subsequently submitted to County Counsel and through the County approval process.

This Agreement has been approved by the Office of County Counsel.
