SUBJECT: HUB JAIL CONCEPT PAPER

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Receive and File attached White Paper entitled, "Hub Jail Concept Paper".

2. Request the Chairman to authorize the formation of a Working Group, comprised of staff from the County Executive Office, Facilities Management, and the Sheriff's Department that will return to the Board in 120 days with a report on recommended site selection, building feasibility, and cost impacts for the hub jails in the western and eastern sections of the County.

BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside is the fastest growing county in California. The need for jail beds has been identified in past submissions regarding the Capital Improvement Plan. The study, the Corrections Facilities Master Plan, recently completed by staff of the CEO, confirms the present need for additional jail beds and outlines the necessity to begin building jails in anticipation of future needs. Given the extended timeline for jail projects, the proposed Work Group should also inquire into the feasibility of utilizing alternative construction technologies (e.g., pre-cast jail cells) for inclusion into the report.
