## Hurricane Disaster Relief Update

As of October 24, 2005, the Housing Authority of the County of Riverside has accepted 201 applications from families displaced as a result of recent hurricane disasters. Of the 201 applications, 11 families were from other counties and will be helped by their local jurisdictions. The statistics are listed below:
