BACKGROUND: cont'd

The Department of Mental Health's Inpatient Quality Improvement and Patient's Rights Office have conducted a review of the facilities listed on Attachment A and have found the program to be in compliance with the criteria for designation. We are, therefore, requesting that the Board designate the facilities for involuntary detention of mentally disordered persons for evaluation and treatment.

In addition, Desert Regional Medical Center, notified the Department that effective September 30, 2005, they will be closing their psychiatric inpatient unit and will no longer accept involuntary detention of mentally disordered persons for evaluation and treatment.

Due to the closure of Desert Regional Medical Center's psychiatric unit, the County of Riverside has only two designated facilities (Moreno Valley Community Hospital and RCRMC) within the county, which necessitates the need to designate additional facilities in bordering counties to meet the needs of the residents of Riverside County.
