SUBJECT: Renaming of Oleander Avenue

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Direct the Riverside County Transportation Department, in cooperation with the City of Perris and the City of Moreno Valley to determine what the costs and impacts would be in changing the name of Oleander Avenue to Harley Knox Boulevard.

BACKGROUND: Harley Knox was a tireless advocate for industrial development in Riverside County, particularly in the areas surrounding March Air Force Base. In his vision for the area, he saw the need for an interchange at Oleander Avenue. This was prior to the construction of the I-215 freeway. Through Harley's efforts, the Oleander Interchange was constructed, opening up valuable industrial land with access to the March Air Reserve Base. This area is providing valuable jobs and economic development to Riverside County. Renaming Oleander Avenue would be one way to recognize Harley Knox for his many contributions to Riverside County.
