BACKGROUND:

HIV disease and Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) remain a significant public health problem in Riverside County. In 2004, the Department of Public Health reported 184 cases of AIDS and 404 cases of HIV disease. Since 1982, 3,188 individuals have died from HIV related complications. World AIDS Day 2005 is an opportunity to encourage people at risk for HIV disease to seek HIV testing and prevention education.

**TO PROCLAIM
WORLD AIDS DAY 2005
Thursday December 1, 2005**

- WHEREAS, since 1982, there have been 6,588 cases of HIV/AIDS reported for the County of Riverside;
- WHEREAS, at least 4,307 persons live with HIV Disease and AIDS in the County of Riverside and bear the burden of this disease;
- WHEREAS, sixty seven (67%) of those who are infected with HIV or are living with AIDS are between 25-44 years old;
- WHEREAS, at least 1,400 men and women are estimated to be infected with HIV and don't know it;
- WHEREAS, the County of Riverside and its community collaborators are committed to continue the fight against HIV;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE KNOWN, that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim that Thursday December 1, 2005, be recognized by the County of Riverside as WORLD AIDS DAY 2005 and encourage all those at risk to seek HIV testing and prevention education.
