BACKGROUND:

The City of Indio is proposing to utilize CDBG funds for the acquisition of an existing building to be used as the new City of Indio Senior Center. CDBG funds will be used to acquire the vacant facility located at 45-700 Aladdin Street, Indio, CA. The facility was previously used as a medical office building and convalescent home.

Having completed the applicable review procedures outlined in 24 CFR Part 505, an evaluation has been made of the potential effects the project shall have on the environment.
