SUBJECT: Approval of the First Amendment to the Administration of Justice Training Services Agreement with the Mt. San Jacinto Community College District

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the First Amendment to the Administration of Justice Services Agreement on behalf of the County with the Mt. San Jacinto Community College District (MSJCCD).

BACKGROUND: Through an Agreement with MSJCCD, approved by the Board on 01/04/05 (3.33), the Sheriff's Department partners with the District to offer a public safety curriculum at the college, and provide college credits to students enrolled in the peace officer training classes. The Department provides the District with instructors and State Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST) course outlines.

On 10/18/05 (3.51), the Board of Supervisors approved a new Clark Training Center rate structure for charging entities that use the Center's classrooms and other facilities. The Sheriff's Department utilizes the student hour rate to charge MSJCCD for its services at the college campus, and now must now amend this Agreement to reflect the new per student hour rate approved by the Board. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.
