**SUBJECT:** Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for the preparation of environmental and design documents for the planned interchange improvements at Indian Truck Trail and Interstate 15, Temescal Canyon area.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

That the Board:

1. Rescind the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and Caltrans, executed by the Board of Supervisors on April 12, 2005 (agenda item 3.16), for the Interchange Improvement project at Indian Truck Trail and Interstate 15, and
2. Approve the attached revised Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and Caltrans, and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the document on behalf of the County. (Caltrans Agreement No. 08-1233).

**BACKGROUND:**

By agenda item No. 3.16 on April 12<sup>th</sup> 2005, the Board of Supervisors approved the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and Caltrans for the Interchange Improvement project at Indian Truck Trail and Interstate 15 (County contract No. 05-03-013, Caltrans Agreement No. 08-1233). Caltrans Legal Office has since reviewed the agreement and discovered that several Articles had been omitted. The revised Agreement is submitted for approval.

Indian Truck Trail and Interstate 15 Cooperative Agreement between the County of  
Riverside and the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for the  
preparation of environmental and design documents.  
December 12, 2005  
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An imminent need for roadway improvements at the Indian Truck Trail and Interstate 15 interchange exists as a result of a significant increase in traffic, due to recent and proposed development in the area. The surrounding land uses in the vicinity of the interchange include commercial retail and residential west of Interstate 15, with light industrial parcels east of Interstate 15.

The Cooperative Agreement between Caltrans and the County of Riverside outlines each agency's responsibilities for the development of the project environmental and design documents.

This agreement is necessary for Caltrans to provide project oversight, quality assurance, including appropriate reviews and approvals of submittals by the County, and to cooperate in timely processing of the project. The cost of project oversight and quality assurance will be borne by the State.

Through a separate agreement between the developer and the County, improvements covered under this agreement will be funded by the developer.
