Subject: Support in Concept of A Salute to Veterans Parade

The event, called A Salute to Veterans, is scheduled to take place at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 22, 2006. As conceived, the parade will follow a route which generally proceeds from RCC down Market Street, turning right on 10th, right again on Main, marching in front of the historic Courthouse and dispersing in the Jury Parking Lot bounded by 14th, Orange and Main. Applications have been submitted to the City of Riverside, RCC has agreed to allow parade staging in its parking lots, insurance has been purchased, flyers and posters with the event's logo are being printed, and the event committee is now turning its attention to securing the actual parade units.

The parade committee will require county permission to a.) utilize the Jury Parking Lot as a parade unit dispersing area, and b.) place a reviewing stand on the Courthouse walkway. Also, some county personnel, such as the Sheriff's Mounted Unit, will be invited to participate in the parade. Accordingly, the Facilities Management Director and the Director of Veterans' Services felt it would be best at the outset to obtain the Board's recognition, support and approval-in-concept of the event, and ask that the Board authorize and encourage the support of county departments.
