**SUBJECT:** Indian Truck Trail/Interstate 15 Interchange Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for the preparation of environmental and design documents.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

That the Board approve and execute the attached Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and Caltrans for the Interchange Improvement project at Indian Truck Trail and Interstate 15. (Caltrans Agreement No. 08-1233).

**BACKGROUND:**

An imminent need for roadway improvements at the Indian Truck Trail/Interstate 15 interchange exists as a result of a significant increase in traffic, due to recent and proposed development in the area. The surrounding land uses in the vicinity of the interchange include commercial retail and residential west of Interstate 15, with light industrial parcels east of Interstate 15.

The Cooperative Agreement between Caltrans and the County of Riverside outlines each agency's responsibilities for the development of the project environmental and design documents.

This agreement is necessary for Caltrans to provide project oversight, quality assurance, including appropriate reviews and approvals of submittals by the County, and to cooperate in timely processing of the project. The cost of project oversight and quality assurance will be borne by the State.

Through a separate agreement between the developer and the County, improvements covered under this agreement will be funded by the developer.
