
SUBJECT: Increases in Contract Amount for NPDES/Fugitive Dust Inspection Professional Services.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors,

1. Approve the increase in the contract with Geopacifica (#TLARC-91810-001-044-03/07) from \$360,000 to \$500,000 for each of FY04/05 and FY05/06 for a total contract amount from \$840,000 to \$1,120,000.
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute the Contract Change Request on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: In March 2004 the TLMA solicited proposals for field and office verification of grading project site compliance with County Ordinance 457 provisions of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), and the proposed Riverside County Fugitive Dust Reduction Program with respect to fugitive dust and the requirements of the Air Quality Management District (AQMD). The proposal submitted by Geopacifica, Inc. received the highest evaluation rating and a 3-year contract was executed. This year water regulatory agencies added increased requirements to the Building & Safety Department including increasing the frequency of site inspections for low, medium and high priority projects. These requirements have increased the number of NPDES inspections over original estimates necessitating an increase in the contract amount. This contract was approved in accordance with BOS Policy A-18. The grading and building permit fees and deposits will be used to pay for all of the contractor's charges.


