SUBJECT: UTILIZATION OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE'S STATE & FEDERAL
LOBBYIST FOR THE HOMELAND SECURITY TASK FORCE

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors authorize the recently established Homeland Security Task Force the ability to utilize the services, on an as-needed basis, the County's Sacramento and Washington lobbying teams.

BACKGROUND: On April 5, 2005, the Board of Supervisors created the Homeland Security Task Force for the purposes of developing a coordinated and comprehensive effort for securing March Air Reserve Base and the Clark Training Facility for the Federal Government's West Coast Training Center for Homeland Security. In order to effectively pursue this project, the services of our County lobbying teams in Sacramento and Washington will be required on an as-needed basis.
