
SUBJECT: Funding for Middle College High School and Gateway to College  
Early High School Program

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board join me in approving \$40,000 in start-up funding from the Youth Protection Trust Fund for the Middle College High School and Gateway to College Early High School Program (MCHS).

**BACKGROUND:** Riverside Community College has started the Middle College High School and Gateway to College Early High School Program (MCHS), which will serve approximately 90 high school students from the Riverside, Jurupa and Alvord Unified School Districts (Supervisory Districts 1 & 2). The funding provided for this program will cover the cost of books and is a one-time cost only, as books will be reused each year.

Therefore, I would like to direct the Auditor-Controller to transfer \$40,000 from the Youth Protection Fund to Riverside Community Colleges Middle College High School and Gateway to College Early High School Program (MCHS), as follows:

Decrease sub-fund reserve equity: (Youth Protection/Intervention)	11072-1000170000-320120	\$40,000.
Increase Appropriation (Special Programs Expense)	10000-1000100000-527780	\$40,000
