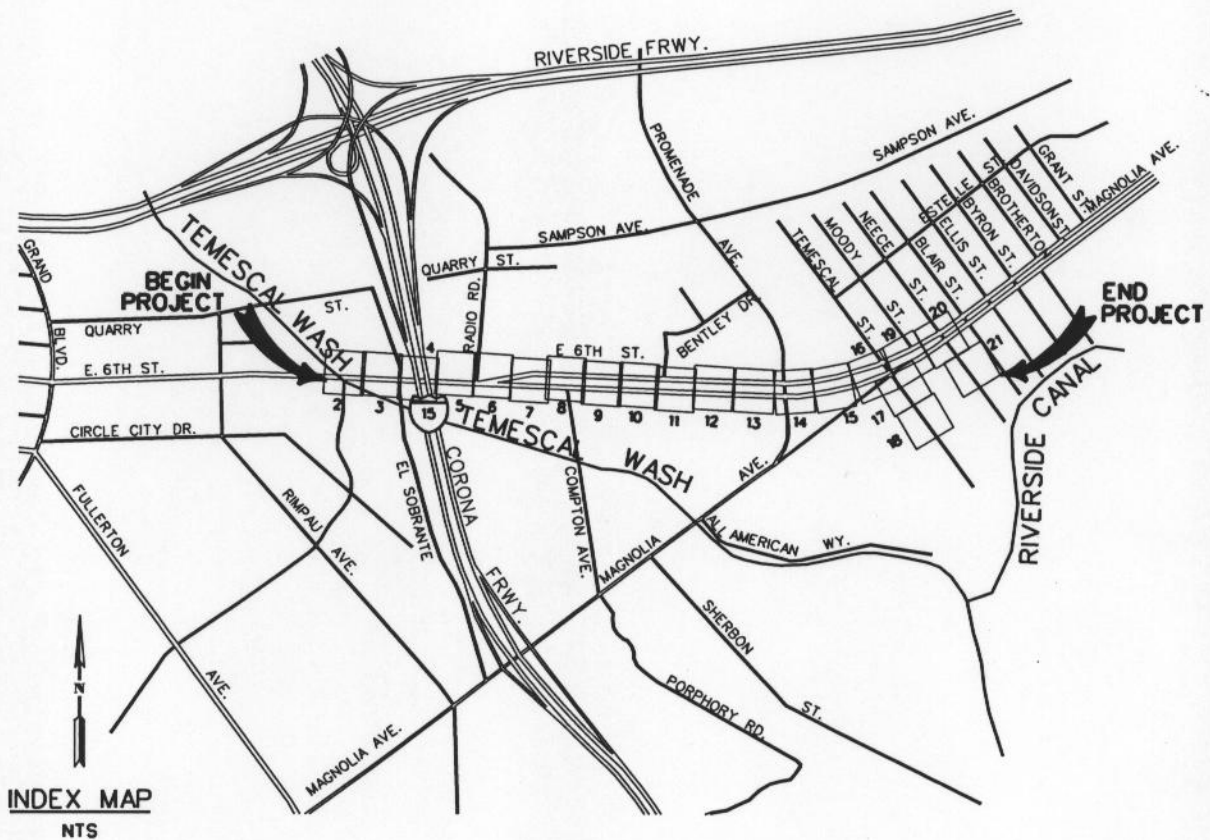

# CORONA DRAIN LINE 46

## STAGE 1

### PROJECT NO. 2-0-0331



Corona Drain Line 46, Stage 1 consists of constructing approximately 6610 lineal feet of an underground storm drain beginning at the confluence with Temescal Wash Channel in the City of Corona, then, easterly along E. 6th Street and Magnolia Avenue in a portion of Riverside County, and ending southeasterly along Temescal Street. Neece Lateral consists of constructing approximately 1150 lineal feet beginning at the intersection of Magnolia Avenue and Temescal Street, then northeasterly along Magnolia Avenue and ending southeasterly along Neece Street.
