SUBJECT: Amendment One to Access Permit from the Orange County Water District for work at River Road Bridge.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors APPROVE Amendment One to the Access Permit between the County Transportation Department and the Orange County Water District.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department has an Access Permit from the Orange County Water District (OCWD) that allows the Department to access OCWD land and remove material deposited under and around the River Road Bridge. This amendment would extend the Permit for a five year period. The OCWD is the landowner in this portion of the Santa Ana River.

The Transportation Department has a contractor removing sand on a continual basis from the river bottom in order to provide sufficient clearance under the bridge. Due to the bridge's location at the entrance of the Prado Debris Basin, most storm events result in a large amount of sand, sediment, brush and Arundo donax being deposited at the bridge. The build up of large quantities of material often result in closure of the bridge due to overtopping or damage to the bridge. Until the bridge is replaced, the Department needs to have access to OCWD lands to be able to protect the bridge. The Department has been actively working on the bridge replacement project for several years to gain approval from the federal and state regulatory agencies that are involved. The current schedule calls for the replacement bridge to be constructed by fall of 2008.

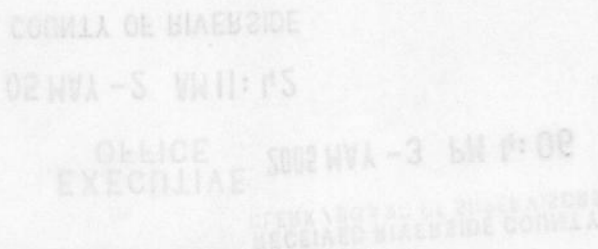
