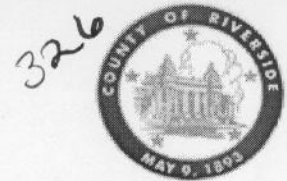

SUBJECT: Approval of Standard Agreement No. 04-036-250-0 with State Water Resources Control Board for Oversight of Underground Storage Tank Cleanup

RECOMMENDED MOTION: 1) Move that the Board approve the standard Agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board for FY 2004/2005 for the contract total of \$318,500. 2) Adopt Resolution No. 2005 -066 authorizing the Chairman to execute four (4) copies of the Agreement on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: The annual State contract is the standard agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board for the County to continue to identify and oversee the investigation and clean up of releases from underground storage tanks. Program costs are fully offset by funding from the State Water Resources Control Board and fees for service.

4 **AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD FOR**
5 **OVERSIGHT BY COUNTY FOR UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP**

6 WHEREAS, the State of California's Agency for Clean Water Programs, designates the
7 State Water Resources Control Board to distribute funds for site cleanup of leaking
8 Underground Storage Tanks pursuant to Section 25297.1 of the California Health and Safety
9 Code and Title 23, Section 2621, Division 3, Chapters 16 and 18 of the California Code of
10 Regulations; and

11 WHEREAS, since 1989 the County of Riverside has maintained through the
12 Department of Environmental Health the Local Oversight Program under the Hazardous
13 Materials Management Division; and

14 WHEREAS, the County has the Local Oversight Program with the means to identify
15 and oversee the investigation and remediation of the Underground Storage Tank petroleum
16 release within its jurisdiction to protect the County groundwater; now, therefore

17 **BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of
18 California, in regular session assembled on May 10, 2005, that the Chairman of this Board is
19 authorized and directed to execute on behalf of said County of Riverside Contract No. 04-
20 036-250-0, dated July 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005, between the County of Riverside and
21 the California State Water Resources Control Board providing for investigation and cleanup
22 from underground storage tank releases.
