RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


- 1) Ratify the attached One Time Only Agreement with Riverside County Foundation on Aging.

Departmental Concurrence

BACKGROUND: Under our agreement with the California Department of Aging (CDA), One Time Only (OTO) funds can be used for the following purposes:

- Purchase of equipment which enhances the delivery of services to the eligible population
- Home and Community based projects, as approved by CDA
- Innovative pilot projects, as approved by CDA


This One Time Only Agreement with the Riverside County Foundation on Aging is for the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, in the reimbursable amount of \$50,000. The services outlined in this agreement have been funded through the Older Americans Act, Special Programs For The Aging, Title III, Part C, Nutrition Services, and approved by CDA, Riverside County Office on Aging Advisory Council and Leadership Team.

This agreement is for an innovative pilot project that will: (1) generate community awareness and understanding of senior hunger issues and lay the groundwork for securing the commitments of resources needed to expand and sustain nutrition programs for seniors at levels that meet the County's current needs; (2) conduct a review of innovative nutrition programs that have proven to be effective in reaching underserved, low income, minority, isolated and at-risk senior populations, and implement effective programs that reach and serve these populations; and (3) create a Senior Nutrition Program model for use in applying for senior nutrition-related Community Development Block Grant funding.

There are no additional match requirements and no impact to the County General Fund.
