SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2004 – 2005 Medical Services Agreements with Contract Clinics for the Medically Indigent Services Program (MISP)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the Medical Services Agreements for the County Network Clinics for the period of July 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005;
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to sign three (3) copies of each Agreement; and
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original of each Agreement and return two (2) fully executed originals of each Agreement to Riverside County Regional Medical Center, Administration.

BACKGROUND: The Contract Clinics provide necessary medical treatment services to MISP eligible patients. The fiscal year 2004-2005 Agreements are comparable to previous annual contracts. Maximum annual compensation per agreement is noted on Page 2.
