**SUBJECT: LETTER OF PROTEST TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF  
CORRECTIONS REGARDING THE PLACEMENT OF SEX OFFENDER  
PAROLEES IN RIVERSIDE COUNTY**

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

That the Board of Supervisors authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign and send a letter to the State Department of Corrections strongly protesting the placement of sex offender parolees in Riverside County.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Board of Supervisors should officially protest the California Department of Corrections continual placement of sex offender parolees in Riverside County.

Last Thursday, May 5, 2005, a high-risk sex offender parolee, David Allyn Dokich, was scheduled for placement in Sun City. At the last possible moment, the placement was changed to a group home in Mead Valley. The last minute change in location for the parolee did not leave any opportunity for residents to protest or prepare for this action.

It is critical that the Board be on record in opposition to these placements, especially near schools, recreational areas and neighborhoods where children and residents would be at risk. The Executive Office with assistance from the Sheriff's office and the District Attorney's office should immediately prepare a letter protesting these actions for the Chairman's signature and send it to the Department of Corrections without delay.
