BACKGROUND: (Continued).

Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch is collaborating with Valley Health System on the ongoing project, Healthy Children Connection, with the goal of promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children 5 years of age and younger. Valley Health System offers services to clients in Districts 1, 3, and 5 with funding through the Riverside County First Five Commission in the amount of \$200,700. The amount of the contract has been renegotiated based on current service level needs and evaluation of expenditures for prior years.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level. Exhibits A, B and C and Attachment A have been modified for the new performance period, and Attachments B and C have been added.
