SUBJECT: Reconstruction of Ramon Road with Portland Cement Concrete paving, Varner Road to Interstate 10 East-Bound Ramp Terminal, Thousand Palms area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board accept the low bid of Griffith Company of Santa Fe Springs, CA in the amount of \$2,092,769.00. Award the contract to that firm and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents. Amend the Transportation Improvement Program's project budget as proposed on Attachment "A".

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated July 12, 2005 (agenda item 3.66) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the reconstruction of Ramon Road with Portland Cement Concrete paving, from Varner Road to the Interstate 10 East-bound ramp terminal, in the Thousand Palms area of Riverside County. The project will remedy the pavement deterioration and rutting that has resulted from the high volume of heavy truck traffic which utilize Ramon Road within the project limits. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 pm, Wednesday,
