**BACKGROUND:**

At the request of the Banning Unified School District (BUSD), State Senator Jim Battin authored SB 405 which was passed by the legislature and approved by Governor Schwarzenegger on June 27, 2005. This legislation redefines the BUSD Library District and gives BUSD the option of forming a separate governing board for the Library District. Subsequently, the BUSD adopted and, now, filed Resolution #05-12-06 with the Clerk of the Board to accomplish the formation of the Banning Library District.

According to SB 405, "Within 60 days after filing with the County Clerk of the County of Riverside of the resolution adopted pursuant to subdivision (a), the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside shall appoint the initial governing board of the library district. The appointments shall be made from the membership of the Library Commission of the Banning Unified School District Library District."

This Form 11 will fulfill that requirement for the Board of Supervisors. The five member Board of Trustees shall determine by lot at their first meeting when their terms shall expire.
