**BACKGROUND:**

In 2005, the Board approved LIHEAP agreements and amendments with CSD to accept program year 2005 funding to: 1) assist low-income consumers with high energy bills, 2) repair or replace heating and cooling devices that contribute to high energy consumption, and 3) weatherize homes. This Agreement #06B-5381 establishes program year 2006 and would continue to provide the same services.

Although the state has not yet received the official 2006 LIHEAP allocation notification from the federal government, this Agreement is being fully funded. If there is a change in funding, this Agreement may be amended.

The Director of DPSS-DCA requests the Board to approve this Agreement #06B-5381 covering the term January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** No County General Funds will be required.
