SUBJECT: Acceptance of Grant Award From the National Children's Alliance for Program Support for the Riverside Child Assessment Team/Child Abuse and Neglect.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Authorize the Chairperson to accept, on behalf of the Board, a \$10,000 grant award from the National Children's Alliance (NCA) for program support of the Riverside Child Assessment Team/Child Abuse and Neglect at Riverside County Regional Medical Center;
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments on the attached Schedule A.

BACKGROUND: The National Children's Alliance (NCA) is a membership organization that supports and advocates on behalf of Children's Advocacy Centers nationwide. Children's Advocacy Centers are facility-based programs, which utilize a multidisciplinary approach (including child protective services, law enforcement, medical and mental health services, victim services and prosecution) to investigate and intervene in child abuse cases. The Victims of Child Abuse Act of 1990, as amended, authorizes the United States Department of Justice Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention to provide funds for the development and implementation of multidisciplinary child abuse investigation programs. One of the many objectives of this project is to provide support to fully accredited eligible member programs of the National Children's Alliance to use in the development of their infrastructure.
