BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside's Emergency Operations Plan, the Multi-Hazard Functional Plan, has been rewritten in accordance with the Governor's Office of Emergency Services recommended plan format. The new Emergency Operations Plan dated February 2006 is in accordance with the Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS), is compliant with the California Emergency Plan and the National Incident Management System (NIMS). 6 implementation of plans for the protection of citizens and property within the County of Riverside in the
7 event of an emergency or disaster condition; and

8 **WHEREAS,** The Governor's Office of Emergency Services has recommended that the
9 Emergency Operations Plan format replace the Multi-Hazard Functional Plan format; and

10 **WHEREAS,** The County of Riverside's Emergency Operations Plan Entitled "County of Riverside
11 Multi-Hazard Functional Plan" was last updated and revised in 1998; and

12 **WHEREAS,** The Emergency Operations Plan, dated February 2006, is in accordance with the
13 Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS), is compliant with the California Emergency Plan
14 and the National Incident Management System (NIMS); and

15 **WHEREAS,** The County Departments have reviewed and concur with the plan; and

16 **WHEREAS,** The Governor's Office of Emergency Services has reviewed the plan and approved
17 it's content; and

18 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEREBY**
19 **ADOPTS** Resolution No. 2006-052 and therefore approves the County of Riverside's Emergency
20 Operations Plan dated February 2006 as the Emergency Operations Plan for the County of Riverside.

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Executive Officer as the Director of Emergency
22 Services and/or the County Fire Department Office of Emergency Services is authorized to amend the
23 Emergency Operations Plan to make those changes which may become necessary in the future to keep
24 the plan current, functional and in accordance with State and Federal guidelines.
