**SUBJECT:** Approval of Provider Service Agreements for the Mecca and Perris Family Resource Centers in Riverside County

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approves the Professional Services Agreements in the format attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman to sign the Agreements with First 5 Riverside at the Family Resource Centers located in Mecca and Perris for the period December 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006;
2. Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to approve and execute any future amendments to the Agreements and exercise renewal options as requested by DPSS; and
3. Authorizes the Director of DPSS to administer the terms of the Agreements.

Departmental Concurrence

**BACKGROUND:**

The goal of the Family Resource Centers (FRCs) is to develop healthy families who live in healthy communities. FRCs function as a hub of community services designed to improve family life, particularly for overburdened or disadvantaged families and children. FRCs engage families in their own problem-solving process which results in psychological, social, and economic self-sufficiency. They utilize community building strategies which involve principles of family support, resident involvement, development of public/private partnerships, and shared accountability.

**BACKGROUND** (continued):

First 5 Riverside has now applied to DPSS to provide services at the Mecca and Perris FRCs. Attached are the agreements with First 5 Riverside.

Community Service Providers at the FRCs must be either a public agency or a private non-profit agency with 501(c) (3) tax exempt status. Providers must be able to provide one or more of the following core services:

- Parenting Skills
- Self-Sufficiency
- Community Action
- Child Abuse Prevention Services
- Resource Development, Information & Referral Services
- Education and Literacy
- Life Skills

Subject to Board approval, First 5 Riverside shall provide assistance to families with children ages 0-5 in applying for the Inland Empire Health Plan "Healthy Kids" program at the Mecca and Perris FRCs.

DPSS requests approval of the attached Community Service Provider agreements.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

No County funds are required. The State Family Preservation Allocation will continue to fund the facility leases for all four FRCs.
