
These appropriations, if approved, will provide substantial economic benefits to the citizens of Riverside County.

3 SUPPORTING FEDERAL APPROPRIATIONS
4 FOR FLOOD CONTROL PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007

5 WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives Committee on Appropriations,
6 Sub-Committee on Energy and Water Development, and the United States Senate Committee on
7 Appropriations, Sub-Committee on Energy and Water Development are holding hearings to
8 consider appropriations for Flood Control and Reclamation Projects for Fiscal Year 2007 and
9 have requested written testimony to be submitted to the committees during March 2006; and

10 WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District supports
11 the continuation of construction efforts on the critical flood control project on Murrieta Creek;
12 the furtherance of construction activities on the Santa Ana River Mainstem project, including
13 Prado Dam; the design and construction of the Heacock and Cactus Channels providing flood
14 protection to March Air Reserve Base; the repair and completion of the Norco Bluffs Bank
15 Stabilization Project; and the continuation of Corps efforts in completing the Special Area
16 Management Plan for the San Jacinto and Santa Margarita River Watersheds.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Riverside
18 County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in regular session assembled on February
19 28, 2006 that they support appropriations by Congress for Fiscal Year 2007 for the following
20 projects:

22	Murrieta Creek Flood Control, Environmental Restoration and Recreation Project Construction – General	\$11,500,000
23	Heacock and Cactus Channels (MARB) Section 205 - Design and Construction	\$6,200,000
24	Norco Bluffs Bank Stabilization Project Construction – General	\$1,000,000
25	San Jacinto & Santa Margarita River Watersheds (Riverside County) Special Area Management Plan (SAMP)	\$532,000
26	Santa Ana River Mainstem Construction – General	\$71,300,000

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the General Manager-Chief Engineer is directed to
28 distribute certified copies of this resolution to the Secretary of the Army, Members of the House
of Representatives Committee on Appropriations and Sub-Committee on Energy and Water
