SUBJECT: Approval of Resolution Number 2006-1 Authorizing the Acceptance of the Reallocation of Grant Funds for the Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant Program, under the 2002 Resources Bond Act, from the City of Canyon Lake to the Park and Regional Park & Open-Space District

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:  
Approve Resolution No. 2006-1 Authorizing the Acceptance of the Reallocation of Grant Funds for the Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant Program, under the 2002 Resources Bond Act, from the City of Canyon Lake to the Regional Park and Open-Space District.

BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside loaned the City of Canyon Lake \$1,000,000 for roadwork as per the agreement approved by the City of Canyon Lake City Council on June 5, 2003. This agreement stipulates the transfer of certain funds in repayment of the loan. Included in the agreement for the repayment is the reallocation of \$28,026 in Park Grant funds received from the State Department of Parks and Recreation through the Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant under the 2002 Resources Bond Act.

**Subject:** Approval of Resolution Number 2006-1 Authorizing the Acceptance of the Reallocation of Grant Funds for the Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant Program, under the 2002 Resources Bond Act, from the City of Canyon Lake to the Regional Park and Open-Space District

The request for approval of the resolution to reallocate funds will increase the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District's allocation of Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant Program, under the 2002 Resources Bond Act (Proposition 40), by \$28,026 from \$3,297,919 to \$3,325,945.

As per the agreement with the City of Canyon Lake, the additional funds will be used in Supervisorial District No. 3 for improvements to the Lake Skinner Recreation Area.

Attached for consideration of your honorable Board's approval is Resolution No. 2006-1 that must be submitted to the State Department of Parks and Recreation as per their administration of the Grant in order to complete the transfer of funds to the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District. The City of Canyon Lake's resolution approving the same action is attached for your reference (see Attachment A).

12 WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the Roberti-  
13 Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant Program, which provides funds for the acquisition and  
14 development of neighborhood, community, and regional parks and recreation lands and  
15 facilities; and

17 WHEREAS, the California Department of Parks and Recreation has been  
18 delegated the responsibility for the administration of the grant program, setting up  
19 necessary procedures; and

21 WHEREAS, the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District has a  
22 grant contract No. C0207610 in the amount of \$3,297,919 to be increased by the  
23 allocation not to exceed \$28,026, and

25 WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reached an agreement with the City of  
26 Canyon Lake that those funds set aside for the City instead should be set aside for the  
27 Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District, Supervisorial District No. 3  
28 (to the extent possible) under the County's open application for such allocation.


1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Riverside County Regional Park and  
2 Open-Space District Board of Directors hereby:

- 3 1. Approves the acceptance of the local assistance funds from the Roberti-Z'Berg-  
4 Harris Block Grant under the 2002 Resources Bond Act, which were allocated to  
5 the City of Canyon Lake instead to be allocated to the Riverside County Regional  
6 Park and Open-Space District under its open application for such funds; and
- 7 2. Approves the expenditure of Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant funds following  
8 the execution of a project application with the California Department of Parks and  
9 Recreation; and
- 10 3. Approves the expenditure of such funds, to the extent possible, be utilized for  
11 appropriate projects within Supervisorial District No. 3; and
- 12 4. Appoints the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District General  
13 Manager or his designee as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and  
14 submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements,  
15 payment requests, and other materials that may be necessary for the completion  
16 of Project(s).

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Canyon Lake Requesting that its Grant Funds for the Per Capita Grant Program under the 2002 Resources Bond Act, Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant be allocated to the County of Riverside, Supervisorial District No. 3, Rather than to the City of Canyon Lake**

Whereas, the people of the State of California have enacted the Per Capita Grant Program which provides funds to meet the urgent need for safe, open and accessible local park and recreational facilities for increased recreational opportunities that provide positive alternatives to social problems, and

Whereas, the California Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the grant program, setting up necessary procedures, and

Whereas, under the procedures established by the California Department of Parks and Recreation the City Council adopted a resolution applying for the Per Capita Allocation, and

Whereas, the City has a grant contract No. CO209030 for this allocation in an amount not to exceed \$28,026, and

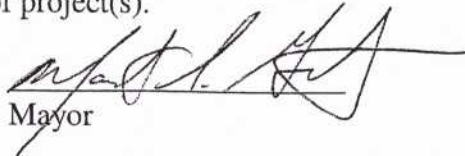
Whereas, the City Council now has reached an agreement with the County of Riverside that those funds set aside for the City instead should be set aside for the County of Riverside, Supervisorial District No. 3 (to the extent possible) under the County's open application for such allocation.

**Now, therefore be it Resolved that the City Council of the City of Canyon Lake**

Requests that the local assistance funds from the Per Capita Grant Program under the 2002 Resources Bond Act, Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Block Grant which were allocated or were to be allocated to the City of Canyon Lake instead be allocated to the County of Riverside under its open application for such funds;

Further requests that to the extent possible such funds be utilized for appropriate projects within Supervisorial District No. 3;

Appoints the City Manager as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to Applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of project(s).
