SUBJECT: Second District Use of Community Improvement Designation Funds

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds for the Corona Police Activities League, Inc. (PAL);
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

Increase Appropriations:

10000-1000100000-536200 **Contrib to Other Non-Co Agcy** \$50,000.00

Decrease Board Designation:

10000-1000100000-320103 Community Improvement \$50,000.00

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to local community organizations dedicated to serving the public. The Corona Police Activities League, Inc. (PAL), has operated a youth center in the downtown area of Corona and the center provides positive educational and recreational activities for youth between the ages of 8 and 18. PAL activities allow members to interact with police officers and other adult role models in a fun, safe and supportive environment. The PAL program is able to show kids that police officers can be their friend and role model, reach out to youth with constructive activities that build discipline and self-esteem, and provide positive alternatives to gangs, drugs and "hanging out" on the streets.
