**BACKGROUND:**

Pursuant to Subtitle B of the Stewart B. McKinley Homeless Act of 1987 (Public Law 100-77), the City of Riverside has been awarded Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funds for the operation and maintenance of emergency shelter facilities. In accordance with program requirements, the City of Riverside would provide to DPSS funding in the amount of \$70,185 for the period of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006 to defray part of the expenses of the family shelter operated by Path of Life Ministries.

Please note that the reason for the delay in bringing this to the Board is that the City usually provides the funding agreement to the County in the second half of the fiscal year. The effective date of July 1 is the City of Riverside's traditional start date for all of their funding agreements, which allows the County to charge any allowable expenses incurred since July 1, 2005.

The Board previously approved a similar City of Riverside ESG agreement on May 17, 2005 (#3.18).

**FINANCIAL DATA:**

Funds for operating the shelters have been included in the fiscal year 2005-06 budget.
