The Community Councils of Thousand Palms, Bermuda Dunes, Mecca, Thermal, Oasis, North Shore, Sky Valley, Indio Hills, Hot Springs, and Vista Santa Rosa are made up of residents who volunteer to participate in monthly meetings and special events such as community clean-ups. The councils provide important input on projects, identify problems and assist the county in improving the community.
