BACKGROUND:

On March 30, 2004 (Agenda #3.18), the Board of Supervisors approved the Amendment No. 1 to the Standard State Agreement No. J19020, which approved adjustments to the salary and fringe benefit line items of fiscal years 2002/2003 through 2004/2005. This was needed to bring DPSS in line with the State's allocation.

DPSS participates in the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) Employment Retention and Advancement Study research project. Due to the Agreement term ending in April 2005, DPSS was not reimbursed for costs incurred in May and June 2005. Therefore, an Amendment to the Contract is needed to extend the term of the Agreement so that DPSS can receive reimbursement of costs incurred for the full quarter (May/June 2005).

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Fully reimbursed with federal funds received by California Department of Social Services. No County funds will be required.
