SUBJECT: Approval of the Amendment #1 to the Agreement #05F-4689 with the Department of Community Services and Development for the 2005 Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and:

- 1) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign Amendment #1 to the 2005 Summer Energy Crisis Response Agreement #05F-4689 between the Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) and the Department of Public Social Services-Community Action Partnership of Riverside County (DPSS-CAP) amending the end of the term from December 31, 2005 to March 31, 2006.

BACKGROUND:

On July 26, 2005 (Agenda #3.45) the Board authorized the activities and purchases for the 2005 Summer Crisis Response. On August 23, 2005 (Agenda #3.74), the Board approved the funding Agreement #05B-5333 for the 2005 Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan. CSD made available \$50,000 in CSBG Discretionary funds to provide services for low-income households.

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BACKGROUND (Cont.):

The services include support of Cool Centers throughout Riverside County and distribution of generators to low-income seniors and disabled individuals who have a life threatening condition requiring the aid of life sustaining medical equipment. The generators provide a back up support system for their medical equipment in the event of a power outage.

Amendment #1 would extend the end of the term of Agreement #05B-5333 from December 31, 2005 to March 31, 2006 to allow for final expenditure for previously approved activities.

Therefore, the Director of DPSS-CAP requests the Board approve Amendment #1 to the Agreement between CSD and DPSS-CAP for the 2005 Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan.
