SUBJECT: Approval of a Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service and the FY 2005-06 Joint Financial and Operating Plans

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors approve the Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service and the current year's Joint Financial and Operating Plans, and authorize the Chairman and the Sheriff to sign all copies of the documents on behalf of the Board.

BACKGROUND: The Forest Service and the Sheriff's Department are requesting renewal of a Cooperative Agreement for law enforcement services, with a new term extending through September 30, 2010. The Agreement, last executed on July 2, 2002 (3.28), provides for law enforcement patrols in the Cleveland and San Bernardino National Forest.

Each year, the Sheriff and the Forest Service execute Financial and Operating Plans pursuant to the Master Cooperative Agreement. Under the FY 2005-06 Joint Financial and Operating Plan, Sheriff's Deputies from the Hemet and Lake Elsinore Sheriff's stations will conduct patrols on National Forest System lands. The operating budget of \$25,000 is divided evenly between the two stations. An additional \$6,000 is offered for training and equipment.

Under the FY 2005-06 Joint Financial and Operating Plan for Controlled Substance Operations, the Sheriff's Department will be reimbursed up to \$4,000 for detection and investigation of persons manufacturing, cultivating or trafficking controlled substances on National Forest System lands. The term of each Plan is from October 1, 2005 to September 30, 2006. County Counsel has approved the Cooperative Agreement and the Joint Operating and Financial Plans as to form.
