SUBJECT: Ratify MOU with San Jacinto Unified School District (SJUSD)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify to November 3, 2005, the MOU between the County and SJUSD;
- 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the MOU.
- 3) Authorize Director of Mental Health to sign the annual SJUSD Consulting Agreement.

BACKGROUND: The San Jacinto Unified School District has been awarded funding for the Early Mental Health Initiative by the State Department of Mental Health. The Early Mental Health Initiative is a research-based, outcome-driven program designed for the early identification and prevention of emotional, behavioral, and learning difficulties in young students (kindergarten through third grade). The goal is to increase the likelihood that participating students will be successful in school.

SUBJECT: Ratify MOU with San Jacinto Unified School District (SJUSD)

BACKGROUND (Continued):

The Early Mental Health Initiative provides funding for trained paraprofessionals to spend one-on-one time with identified students in an equipped activity room designed for play. SJUSD has agreed to reimburse the Riverside County Department of Mental Health (RCDMH) a maximum of \$6,536 per fiscal year until June 30, 2008. No additional County funds are required.

Justification for Delay:

SJUSD intended to contract with RCDMH for training and clinical grant funded services. SJUSD initiated the MOU with RCDMH on February 28, 2006.
